July hog price show sharp contrasts China total import meat of 854,000mt in July; Jan – June total of 5.9mmt

- July hog prices showed sharp contrasts again, with China and Vietnam well below last year's high levels and China now below the 5-year average. While prices were sharply higher in most other countries, although most modest in EU, the top supplier to China. Japan's hog prices rebounded in June and July, and in yen terms were even last year's high levels
- <u>EU exports</u> to China fell in June but growth elsewhere(except UK) kept volumes just 2% shy of year-ago...pivot back to Japan and everywhere else
- <u>China</u> took 50% of EU-27 exports in June, down from a 64% share in June 2020.
- <u>Mexico</u> pork exports continued to grow, up 14% in H1. Japan remained the top market, but growth was to China, US,
 Korea and Canada
- <u>Taiwan 's</u> pork imports surge from EU and Canada and domestic hog prices hit new high. Supermarket and ecommerce sales rose with covid lockdown in June, foodservice was a hard hit
- <u>Brazil's</u> pork exports were dominated by China, underpinning the 14% growth in the first seven months, to 651,000mt, of which 53% was China-bound, or 347,350mt, up 23%. July shipments to China at 50,785 mt were down only slightly form last year, despite higher Brazilian prices and lower Chinese pork prices.





Japan, South Korea Regulatory update

1# Japan Import documents

On May 31st, 2021, the Ministry of health, labor and welfare of Japan issued <u>Notice No. 0531</u>. Based on the relevant provisions of the *food hygiene law*, when importing **livestock** and poultry **meat**, **organs and their meat products** for sale, there must be a **hygiene certificate** issued by the government of the exporting country or **add relevant copies**. If the contents of relevant supporting documents for the import of these products are incomplete, the embassy or the local government has recorded and added relevant certificates of relevant matters, which shall also be recognized.

2# Japan Veterinary drugs limited

In June 2021, the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare of Japan summarized the modified residue limits for veterinary drugs such as tetrodinium in pork products in recent years. The details of the modified limits are as follows.

3# South Korea Veterinary drugs limited

On June 29th, 2021, the Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (MFDS) of South Korea issued a <u>partial amendment to *Food Code*</u> to amend the method of applying the veterinary drug standards to animal products (including cattle, pigs, chickens, milk, eggs) and aquatic products where separate residue limits are not specified, the positive list system is applicable (i.e. the uniform standard of 0.01mg/kg).





Taiwan, Singapore Regulatory update

1# Taiwan Test method of veterinary drug

On May 24th, 2021, Taiwan issued a method for the determination of animal drug residues in food, which is for the multiple residue analysis of antigenants in muscle, viscera and eggs of livestock and poultry products.

2# Taiwan Import quarantine

On July 2nd, 2021, Taiwan amended the *Quarantine Procedures for Imported Animal Products transported in Closed Containers*. For related enterprises exporting to Taiwan, if the original seals of their products are to be replaced within the territory of non-epidemic countries (regions), they should obtain the English certificate issued by the animal quarantine authorities, customs authorities, port authorities or relevant government departments of the non-epidemic countries (regions). In the case of replacement of the original seal on the means of transport, a certificate in English issued by the master or captain of the means of transport shall be obtained.

3# Singapore Product import source

On <u>April 1st</u>, <u>June 1st</u> and <u>Aug 2nd</u>, 2021, the Singapore Food Authority (SFA) released *the list of new farms and establishments applied to export to Singapore for 3 times*, including frozen pork meat and/or pork offal's from Japan, Belgium, Brazil, France, Germany; ham from Spain; chilled and frozen pork from Sweden, etc.





Taiwan's pork imports surge from EU & Canada and domestic hog prices hit new high of US\$1.39/1b, +16%

Taiwan supermarket and ecommerce sales rose with covid lockdowns in June and foodservice was hard-hit: according to moea, in July food service down 38.8%

- According to the Ministry of Economic Affairs (MOEA), sales in Taiwan's retail and food/beverage sectors in June posted the largest declines for the month in 22 years because of restrictions imposed to combat the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Retail sales slumped 13.3% year-on-year to NT\$266.4 billion (US\$9.5 billion) in June, while food and beverage sales nosedived 39.9% to NT\$38.3 billion, both the biggest drops for the month since these statistics were first compiled in 1999, MOEA figures showed. MOEA Department of Statistics deputy chief Huang Wei-Chieh attributed the plunge to bans on onsite dining and drinking at restaurants and stores and other restrictions imposed in mid-May under aLevel 3 alert after COVID-19 cases surged to over 100 per day. Under the Level 3 alert, the government has repeatedly urged people not to leave their homes to go out unless necessary, leading to sharp declines in visits to department stores, convenience stores, and other retail businesses.
- Supermarket sales also rose 33.2% as people consolidated their shopping to minimize time spent outside. Convenience stores, which had to suspend dine-in services and sales of prepared foods to prevent the spread of COVID-19, saw their revenue declined 7.4% year-on-year to NT\$28.3 billion in June. The food/beverage sector also experienced a major downturn mainly because of the in-person dining ban, with sales in June falling 40.4% to NT\$31.6 billion from June 2020. The main beneficiaries of people staying home were e-commerce. The online retail sector saw sales rise 33.7% in June from a year earlier to NT\$25.5 billion.



PH: the Philippines' agriculture ministry said on Aug. 19 active cases of African swine fever were declining and confined to less than 1% of the nearly 3,000 villages that recorded outbreaks since the first cases were detected in 2019, Domestic meat surplus starting in 2023

- On Aug 20th, Reuters reports that the fall in infections and an on-going government-funded hog repopulation program had put the Southeast Asian country on track to be able to produce a domestic meat surplus starting in 2023, the ministry said. The Philippines, the world's seventh-biggest pork importer before local demand was hammered by the pandemic, has been hit hard by such outbreaks and forced to ramp up pork importation to address an acute domestic shortage and temper food inflation.
- "(Active cases are) waning and confined now to just 22 villages," ministry spokesman Noel Reyes told a media briefing.
- The number of positive samples in August was the lowest over the last 12 months, government data showed.
- The government has launched a 29.6 billion pesos (\$586 million) programmed to boost local pork production focusing on pig repopulation, extending financial assistance to hog raisers, and strengthening biosecurity to control the spread of the virus
- Philippines' DA temporarily extends validity of SPSICs for imported meat to 90 days: Citing requests of stakeholders to extend the current 60-day validity of SPS Import Clearances (SPSIC) due to current global COVID situation, supply contraction of container vans, and other logistical difficulties, the DA has released Administrative Order No. 09, which extends the validity of SPSICs for imported meat to 90 days. The temporary extension will be in effect from August 10 to December 31, 2021. MITA appealed to the DA for the said extension, thru a letter sent to DA Secretary Dar, last June.

Phillipines: DA, DTI maintian pork tariff cut benefitted consumers

- At a House hearing recently, DA Secretary Dar presented the effects of Executive Orders 133 and 144 which increased the minimum access volume for pork meat and adjusted the tariff rates on pork imports, respectively, on the prices of pork products in local markets.
- He said the prices of frozen pork ham is now at P220 per kilogram while frozen pork belly is now at P250 per kilogram. "We largely attributed this to EO 133 and 134 which reduced pork import tariff and increased pork imports allocation to bring down pork prices," Dar told the lawmakers.
- On the other hand, DA director for Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service Dr. Ramon Yedra said the prices on local pork produce have also "dropped." Based on DA's survey last Monday, Yedra said the price of pork ham/shoulder now ranges from P300 to P330 per kilogram compared to its previous price which ranges from P340 to P350. The price of belly is now at P360 from previous price at P370 and P400 last January.
- Furthermore, DTI Undersecretary Ruth Castelo said that they were given accommodation by frozen meat importers to sell the products at lower prices because of the lowering of tariff rates. The Trade department has launched a program called "Presyong Rasonable Dapat" on frozen meats, which offered pork belly at P250 per kilogram, ground pork at P200 per kilogram, and pork shoulder for P220 to 230 per kilogram.
- In the same hearing, Dar also assured that efforts to help the livestock sector, which heavily dragged the performance of the country's agriculture sector during the first half of the year, recover from ASF are in full force.

GUIDELINES ON THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MINIMUM LABELLING REQUIREMENTS FOR IMPORTED MEAT

The Philippine National Meat Inspection Agency (NMIS) and the Bureau of animal industry (BAI) issued a joint memorandum circular (MC) No. 1 series of 2021 on Aug 10th, 2021, reiterating that the "minimum labeling requirements for imported meat" will be strictly implemented, and provides guidelines to the consignee/importer for the modification of non-compliant labels of imported meat in cold storage warehouses under NMIS supervision.

The regulatory sources of minimum labeling requirements mentioned in the guide include <u>DA AO No.26 s 2005</u> and <u>DA AO No.24 s 2010</u>.

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON LABELING OF MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS





Other Asia Pacific Countries/ Regions Require Expiry Date to be Presented on the Label of Imported Prepackaged Meat and Meat products

Hongkong

Pre-packaged foods should be labelled with a "Use by" date if they are susceptible to microbiological concerns and may pose a ready-to-eat risk to human health after a short period of storage. In other cases, label "Best before" date.

Taiwan

The container or outer package of food should be marked with the expiry date. The expiry date is the end date by which a commercially available packaged food product can retain its value under specific storage conditions. Foods whose expiry date depends on proper storage conditions (e.g. cold storage, freezing, etc.) should be indicated on the label.

South Korea

Expiration date/Sell by date/EXP or E is required for meat products and packaged meat products (including import products).

Note: For raw materials that are simply processed and repackaged without changing the storage conditions without removing the outer packaging; For ready-to-eat meat products that are unpacked and repackaged and for packaged meat products that are repackaged, if you want to label the date of repackaging on the product, you should indicate the date of production and the period of circulation.

Japan

Pre-packaged processed foods sold directly to consumers must have a bestbefore date or expiration date. Fresh meat (raw meat of livestock and poultry) should also label best-before date or expiration date (shelf life under 5 days label best-before date, others label expiration date).

Singapore

Pre-packaged foods that required to be stored at a chilling temperature to maintain or prolong its durable life should be labeled with an expiration date. Raw meat, etc (raw minced or chopped meat and raw organs, but shall exclude processed or manufactured food products such as corned, cured, pickled or salted meat, smoked meat, hamburger meat and other burger meat) should also be labeled with the date of packaging.

Vietnam

The expiry date must be mandatory on the product label, which means that the product is fully fit for sale under the conditions specified on the label, and that the specific quality of the food product is maintained during this period.





Vietnam: Biggest port resume normal operations; ASF resurfaces in the Mekong region

- Vietnam's biggest port, Cat Lai, has resumed normal operations after being almost paralyzed for a week due to mobility restrictions in the south. Its ratio of uncleared containers is now back to the normal 85 percent, and it is again fully capable of receiving goods as the economy recovers, Truong Tan Loc, marketing director of Saigon Newport Corporation, its operator, said.
- The waiting time for a ship to dock is now under eight hours, which is considered very good for ports, said Bui Van Quy, director of the port.
- HCMC-based Cat Lai is exhorting businesses to quickly come and pick up their cargo.
- Companies that have been shut down due to Covid-19 will have their cargo transported to inland container depots for free.
- Cat Lai Terminal stopped receiving oversized and overweight cargo on August 5 after a container pileup due to travel restrictions and closure of companies due to Covid.
- If the outbreaks are controlled by the end of this quarter, the volume of goods passing through the port is set to increase by 5-7 percent this year.

ASF resurfaces in the Mekong region

• Bac Lieu province in Vietnam's Mekong Delta, has reported several outbreaks of ASF after being free of the virus for some time. The outbreaks occurred in several backyard farms, raising awareness once again on the importance of biosecurity. Nguyen Duy Hung, Head of Bac Lieu Province's Department of Livestock and Veterinary Medicine said the outbreak is under control. However, farmers in the Mekong region are concerned about the high risk of infection as they share a common water source.

Brazilian soybeans have gained momentum and again surpassed US. US and Ukraine are the primary suppliers of corn to China

China's imports of US meat and poultry increased by 11%, to 753,280mts, value increased by 25% to \$2billion; Pork meat 272,384mt

In June:

China's imports from Spain were the lowest since Nov but were still up 24% yoy, Brazil were up 33%, Denmark up 19%; US down 32%, Canada down 54%, Chile down 11%, Mexico down 39%





China's live hog price averaged 15.14%RMB/kg on Aug 15, down about 57% from last year. In USD prices averaged \$1.06/1b and are below producers break evens. Dalian futures are in the range of 17.7 – 19 RMB/kg, just above producers break evens

- Some northern areas are affected by heavy rainfall. According to NDRC, the national hog/fed ratio in the first week of August was 4.96, a drop of .2% from previous month, It has entered the first-level warning range. The central and local governments may restart pork purchasing in the near future.
- On June 2nd, a prevention plan for adjusting pork market has been issued: if Hog/feed ratio from 5:1 6:1 lasts for 3 weeks; or sow stock decreased from 5% 10% for 3 months, is categorized as 2nd-level-warning; And 1st-level-warning will be initiated if hog/feed ratio is lower than 5:1, or the stock of sows decreased 10% for 3 months consecutively.
- When it enters the 1st-warning category, china will launch the national reserve; Other indicators such as sow stock numbers, as well as the average pork lean meat price in 36 cities are also the factors to be considered.
- Besides, MARA has built a supervision system for 180,000 hog farms, which are over 500 heads per year/per farm, accounting for 60-70% total production in China.





China's hog producer losses, covid impact restrain the consumption

- Recently, the spread between the north and the south has enlarged significantly. The reason for the slight decline in the Northeast is mainly because the large-weight and over-sized hogs that were previously kept in the pens have been sold in large quantities during this period. There were still certain number of large-weight hogs that have not been sold in the northeast, and it is expected that the price of hogs in the northeast continues to remain weak.
- In the south, after the price of hogs rose, the number of market hogs increased, but there was no obvious improvement on the consumer side. Due to the severe situation in the prevention and control of the novel coronavirus epidemic in some areas in the south, some places issued documents restricting group meals, which had a certain impact on the catering industry.
- Even though six ministries' announcement on supporting hog industry brings certain confidence on hog raisers, the poor consumption continues to retrain hog prices. Besides, the increase in feed prices has also increased the burden on hog raisers.
- Recently, Shandong Provincial Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Bureau released the second quarter livestock and poultry breeding cost and income calculation, listing the details of various breeding costs.
- The break-even line of farrow-to-finish model is 17.75 yuan/kg, and the loss is about 162 yuan; the break-even line of wean-to-finish is 24.37 yuan/kg, and the loss is 956 yuan. At present, hog breeding is still in a state of overall loss. Contrast with: At present, the cost of farrow-to-finish model of most small-scaled farms is hovering between 14 yuan/kg, and Muyuan is currently about 14-16 yuan/kg. Among large-scaled companies, Muyuan is relatively the lowest cost enterprise. Zhengbang's current comprehensive cost is about 20-24 yuan/kg, New Hope's comprehensive cost is 22-26 yuan/kg, and Wen's comprehensive cost is relatively high at 28-32 yuan/kg.




A ban of frozen products in northern market due to epidemic control of covid impact; purchase volume by foodservice industry has dropped; unofficial estimation of 1 mmt imported frozen pork meat in cold store

- •. According to boyar's investigation, there is indeed a ban on the sale of frozen products in northern market. Besides, the areas such as Zhengzhou, Henan and Yangzhou, Jiangsu with stricter epidemic control, the catering industry has been suspended, and the frozen product market has been greatly hit. The sales of fresh products has increased, which is mainly due to the increase in household fresh pork purchase. The purchase volume by foodservice industry has dropped significantly
- The demand side is still negative for market transactions. Especially due to the impact of the novel coronavirus epidemic, many places have strict prevention and control supervision, and roads in some areas are blocked, which affects pork transportation and consumption. Traders were less motivated to replenish products and increase inventory. The shipment of pork carcass in the wholesale market is slow and there is a phenomenon of leftovers. The resurgence of epidemic delays the rise of hog prices again.
- Estimated as 1mmt of imported frozen pork meat in cold stores, published by (Qinbao Net) on Aug. 14th.
- The coming Mid-autumn festival and National day may push a little bit the price, but very limited. Cause on one side the continuously lowered price of pork meat has already dragged back some consumption; and the necessity for empty the stock will all affect the increase of the pork price.
- The light of the tunnel maybe at the end of 2021 and early of 2022, because the continued lower price from June 2021 positively also prohibits the willingness of breeders from increasing its stock, which consequently lower the slaughtering at the end of 2021 or early of 2022.










Week of August 15th Price Index






2019 – 2021 Hog average Price, wholesale market pork price











China's Cold Chain Supervision System



Ms. Zhengyangyang, the total team is 60 people



The cold chain base with a capacity of 10mmts, mainly dealing with all imported food from EU and Latin America

- On August 12th, The CCTV Economic Channel reported on "Building a Strong Imported Cold Chain Food Epidemic Prevention Network" and reported on Binhai New Area and Tianjin Port cold chain food import companies, cold chain logistics companies, market supervision and management departments, and cold chain food sales companies working together to build a strong specific measures for the imported cold chain food epidemic prevention network.
- Tianjin Port is an important port for the import of cold chain food in China. Zheng Yangyang, a stevedores in a logistics cold chain base, has spent nearly 260 days and nights in the sealed control area of the base, also known as the "red zone", since November 2020, when the logistics cold chain base implemented the closed loop management of stevedores.
- After the disinfection is completed, the goods should be left standing for 30 minutes to allow the liquid medicine to play a role in disinfection. After that, the nucleic acid testing agency will sample the goods according to the required points. After the sampling is completed, the goods are wrapped and left to rest for 30 minutes, which is an operation process of warehousing.

Cold Chain supervision still very strict

Heilongjiang: "closed loop" control of imported raw materials

• Recently, Heilongjiang government held a video conference on the epidemic prevention and control work of cold chain food industry enterprises across the province to urge municipal cold chain food industry enterprises to do a good job in epidemic prevention and control and traceability of imported raw materials.

Beijing: Strengthen the supervision of imported cold chain food

•Beijing Municipal Bureau of Market Supervision implied that it will strengthen the supervision of imported cold chain food. The frequency of nucleic acid testing in the agricultural market will be increased. New employees in the agricultural market, employees in imported cold-chain food, and sanitation and cleaners involved in imported cold-chain food, can only engage in operations and other activities in the market with a negative nucleic acid test within 3 days.

12 food production and operation units in Weihai, Shandong were suspended for rectification due to violations of cold chain food epidemic prevention and control requirements

• In the past few days, Weihai, Shandong's market supervision departments continued to increase the supervision and inspection of food production and business units, and "zero tolerance" for violations of imported cold chain food epidemic prevention and control requirements. A few days ago, 12 food production and business units have been suspended for rectification.

Honghu City, Hubei province issued the latest announcement on the prevention of imported cold chain food import risk

• In addition to the strict disinfection and complete certificates and traceability, the announcement also mentioned that smuggling of imported cold-chain food and impersonation of imported cold-chain food as domestic products will be strictly dealt with in accordance with the law





Price Gap further eexpand under Chinese government encouraging "meat transfer" instead of "pig transfer" ASF prevention working plan issued in May Guangdong take the lead, later followed by other provinces




- On August 15th, according to recent notice issued by Guangdong government on adjusting the transport measures for live pigs and live pig products meat" transfer instead of "pig transfer", Guangdong stopped the transfer of pigs from outside the Central south district
- It was decided to stop the transfer of live pigs from slaughter that has passed the "point-to-point registration of live pigs from non-Central and Southern regions into Guangdong province from August 15th. It was decided to stop the transfer of live pigs from slaughter that has passed the "point-to-point registration of
- In early of 2019, Chinese government has planed this strategy by launching from Guangdong province, later followed by Fujian, Jinangxi, Hunan, Guangxi, and Hainan where aligned with the prevention of ASF in central south of China.
- In May 2021, ASF Prevention Working Plan Strengthened the "Meat Transfer" again, 5 areas were circled with leading by one province in each area to carry out this plan.

- According to MARA, there have been 11 ASF outbreaks in eight provinces so far this year, resulting in 2,216 pigs being killed. According to official information, 13,500 animals were culled in 19 outbreaks last year. This means that the number of infections has fallen sharply, as more than 800,000 pigs were emergency killed in 99 epidemic cases in 2018

- Yunnan, Gansu, Guizhou, Sichuan changed from "Transfer in to "Transfer out"





2017-2021年全国能繁母猪存栏情况(万头)





2016 - 2021 Pork meat import (10 thousands tones)







2019 – 2021 monthly hog breeding expected profit (RMB/head)










Yonghui – biggest Supermarket Chain innovates and provides standardized premade dishes

Some pig companies are developing and promoting pre-made dishes Other listed pig companies such as Tianbang shares, Wen's shares, Tangrenshen and Delis all indicated their developing and promoting "pre-made" dishes to open up the "breeding-catering" link



- Pre-made dishes started in year of 2000
- Developed in recent years due to the necessity for frozen/fresh technics, logistics, central kitchen efficiency as well as postcovid effect
- According to Tianmao, sales of pre-made dishes increased by 16 times of last year
- According to Yonnghui Supermarket, their sales volume increased 12% compared to 2020, and especially welcomed by young consumers.
- Another big Food-service restaurants of "Xibei", with 200 restaurants around China, has made "pre-made" dishes as its important categories for on-line brand
- Pre-made dishes mainly coming from pork and poultry meat





Digitalization sweeps catering industry
Issued by Beijing-based research consultancy, said that digitalization is the current main trend in China's catering
large catering enterprises are increasingly investing in digitalization; small and medium sized companies ramp up efforts in digital transformation



Haidilao Catering save 37% with its digitalization

- Data from the National Bureau of Statistics showed that in 2020, despite challenges brought by COVID-19, China's catering industry totaled nearly 4 trillion yuan (\$616.8 billion) in business, on-line food orders surged 107.9%, digital catering took up an increasing share.
- Hotpot chain Haidilao launched a smart restaurant in Shanghai in April, apart form dishserving robots, robotic arms are equipped in warehoused to arrange raw materials. From ordering to serving, the dishes are produced automatically. Haidilao said the system can save nearly 37 percent of back kitchen labor costs.
- "China's 14th Five-Year Plan (2021-25) clearly points out that digital transformation of the service industry will be further promoted. At present, the online and offline integrated development of the catering industry has become a general trend, and the trend has reshaped both the supply and demand sides," said the report.


Starbucks has brought plant-based products to Chinese consumers

- Rising awareness of health and wellness is behind the popularity of plant-based protein-rich foods among consumers be they mock meats available at restaurant chains or dairy products offered at stores and cafes.
- "There is the projection that global protein demand will increase by 70 percent over the next 30 years, which means we will need both animal proteins and alternative proteins to meet rising demand.
- Euromonitor International said China's meat substitute market rose from \$8.04 billion in 2015 to \$10.81 billion in sales revenue in 2020, and it projected the scale to reach \$14.15 billion in 2025.


